





- 2) Here sign in using your **Yahoo** account.
- 3) Type your new Flickr screen name and click this  button.
- 4) After signing in to Flickr, visit the url <http://www.flickr.com/services/API/> and click the following link as explained in the screen shot given below:

## Europeana

### Steps:

- 1) Visit the url <http://www.europeana.eu/portal/api/registration.html>.
- 2) Enter your email address here and click **Register for the API**.
- 3) Check your inbox. Here you will see an email from **Europeana**. Follow the instructions here to complete your registration.
- 4) Now fill in the required form and you will have the required API.

## Pixabay

### Steps:

- 1) Visit the url <http://pixabay.com/api/docs/>.
- 2) Login if you are already a member or Signup for the new account.
- 3) Your API key will be shown after successful login.

### Request parameters
